

Trustee Responsibilities for Natural Resource Damage Assessment and Restoration

Trustees:

- collect and analyze information to assess the type and level of injuries to natural resources and the loss of services provided by these resources;
- develop a plan to restore injured resources to their pre-incident condition; and
- implement the plan.
