The Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM); the Department of Interior, U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service; and the Indiana Department of Natural Resources (DNR) invite public comments about the Natural Resource Damage Assessment Settlement Restoration Plan for the White River. The White River is located in Marion County, Hamilton County and Madison County. The Restoration Plan outlines actions which will restore, rehabilitate, replace, and/or acquire the equivalent of any natural resources and services injured by the release of hazardous substances into the Upper West Fork of the White River. The Trustees, who are associated with the government agencies listed above, feel the actions outlined in the Restoration Plan will compensate for damages to the natural resources that were injured.
