Description	<p>Target Audience: Anyone interested in planning, designing, or implementing habitat restoration.</p> <p>Summary and Objectives: This course provides restoration practitioners a foundation in restoration policy and planning by covering the federal authorities for restoration; compliance requirements, including the National Environmental Policy Act; general principles of restoration science; and the steps involved in developing a restoration plan within the context of landscape-scale conservation and climate change. Case studies will exemplify building partnerships and other key concepts of the course.</p> <p>Upon completion of this course, participants will be able to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Describe federal authorities supporting habitat restoration; • Explain fundamental concepts of restoration ecology; • Develop successful partnerships and communicate effectively with partners and stakeholders; • Prepare a framework for a restoration plan, developing alternatives in a landscape context; and • Given a watershed exercise, illustrate the iterative and adaptive nature of restoration planning.
