Description	<p><u>Please disregard the seat total for this class in DOI Talent, all students go to a waitlist until we enroll.</u></p> <p>This is an overview of the species status assessment (SSA) framework, which is an analytical approach developed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service to deliver foundational science information for all Endangered Species Act decisions. The overview will cover the basic concepts and minimum requirements of an SSA and will show you how to diagnose the level of complexity and expertise required to complete an SSA.
