Course Title	Transitioning to ArcGIS Pro
Description	<p>This 4 hour on-line FWS instructor lead/hosted course utilizes 4 short exercises which will guide existing ArcMap users through the fundamentals of migrating to ArcGIS Pro.</p> <p>Using a format similar to classroom instruction, students will attend virtually using a live WebEx account with instructors leading students through a series of demonstrations and exercises.</p> <p>Students will work through the exercise on their own with the instructor(s) available for questions and live WebEx demonstrations when requested. Each individual exercise will take 20-30 minutes to complete. When finished, instructors will review the exercise, solicit questions, then move onto the next exercise in the series.</p> <p>Requirements:</p> <p>Students should have a good internet connection and the latest version of ArcGIS Pro installed prior to attending.
